***Adopting the Jefferson County, Colorado
Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan 2010***

Whereas, Lookout Mountain Water District recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, Lookout Mountain Water District is located within the Planning Area, and fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, the Colorado Division of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials have reviewed the Jefferson County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Lookout Mountain Water District, hereby adopts the Jefferson County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, as an official plan; and

Be it further resolved, Jefferson County Emergency Management will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Colorado Division of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials to enable the Plan's final approval.
